On 11-09-09 at approximately 2124 hrs Sparks Police Officers received a report that a 14 yr old female had runaway from her residence and taken a handgun from the residence with her. The father of the juvenile reported that he had spoken to her on the phone and that she was some where in the area of the Raley's located on Keystone Ave in Reno. Sparks and Reno Police Officers responded to the area to attempt to locate the juvenile. As officers were responding to the area they received information that the juvenile was with another female juvenile in the bathroom at Raley's and that she had the hand gun in her possession. Officers set up a perimeter around the Raley's and temporarily evacuated the store. An officer made contact with the 14 yr old female on her cell phone and she agreed to exit the store. Both female juveniles exited the store and were taken into custody. The stolen hand gun was located inside the bathroom. The 14 yr old juvenile was booked on the above listed charges. The other female juvenile was taken in to custody as a Child in Need of Supervision
